(X)	<p>Students' engagement in learning increases when students have a voice in their collaborative e-learning experiences.</p> <p>Student engagement in learning increases when students have a choice and a voice in collaborative e-learning experiences. When students are more engaged in learning, they progress steadily toward mastery of learning goals. This is why building choice into collaborative e-learning design is essential.</p>
(!)	<p>Students' mental health improves when they have a voice in their collaborative e-learning experiences.</p> <p>While students' mental health may benefit from having a voice in collaborative e-learning, this is not the essential reason for building voice and choice into the collaborative e-learning design.</p>
( )	<p>Students' behavior challenges are avoided when students have a voice in their collaborative e-learning experiences.</p> <p>While students' behavior challenges may be averted when students are interested in what they are learning, this is a side benefit of K-12 students having a voice in collaborative e-learning.</p>
( )	<p>Students' leadership skills are honed when they have a voice in their collaborative e-learning experiences.</p> <p>While students' leadership skills may be developed in collaborative e-learning experiences, this is not a direct result of having a voice in collaborative e-learning.</p>
